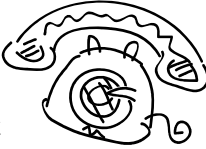

**There is no school Monday, September 1st, as it is a national holiday.**

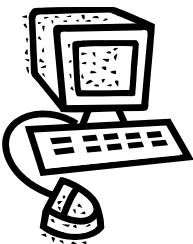
### EMERGENCY INFORMATION: STORMS & SCHOOL

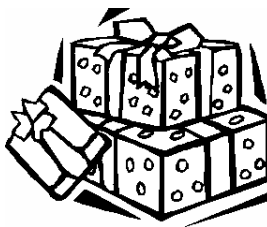

### MORNING ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

When arriving in the morning on the office side of the school, please help with safety concerns and **DO NOT allow your child to exit the car by the music room.** Wait until your vehicle is next to the office or the walkway before allowing your child to depart from your vehicle. It is very difficult to see children when they are walking with the flow of traffic.

Also, please make only a right turn onto Burnside when exiting the office parking lot in the morning. This allows the traffic to flow and allows shuttle students to arrive on time. Turning left creates a traffic jam in our lot and makes the shuttle leave late.

### AFTERNOON DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Please use your designated car rider sign. Hang it from your rearview mirror or place on the right side of your dashboard. This makes the process easier, especially on rainy days.
